Responsibilities include assessment, development and monitoring of treatment programs, consultation with parents/caregivers and other service providers, and assistance with resource needs. Some travel within Northern Ontario and catchment area may be required.

To be considered for this position, candidates should meet the following criteria:

- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Previous experience working with children
